Position Purpose:

The incumbent, under the direct supervision of the Environmental & Planning Director, is assigned tasks in the field and office in the areas of: fisheries, wildlife, ecology, wetlands, and water quality studies; habitat restoration or enhancement projects; stream maintenance; mitigation monitoring; environmental compliance and permitting; water use efficiency; watershed and environmental education; and/or public outreach; assists in the preparation of reports and materials and compilation of data; associated grant reporting; and performs related duties as required. The incumbent will also support the work of staff engaged in developing and implementing the Tribe's environmental projects and programs that are either Tribal strategic goals or grant funded opportunities.
