

### Proposed 2020 TFAP Changes for Renewal

1. Section I(7) p.2
  - a. Change dates to “Beginning May 1, 2020 through April 30, 2023”
2. Section I(8) p.2
  - a. Changed dates of the viewing period
3. Section I(11)
  - a. Added Dual Eligibility Language
4. Section II(2) p.4
  - a. Changed asset limit to \$20,000
  - b. Added language to match 45 CFR 286.5 “or has not attained 19 years of age and is a full time student in a secondary school (or in the equivalent level of vocational or technical training)
  - c. Added language “an Indian adolescent enrolled in public high school receiving special education services through an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan may receive assistance services through the age 22”.
5. Section II(4) p.5
  - a. Changed asset limit to \$20,000
6. Section V(1) p.10
  - a. Changed asset limit to \$20,000
7. Section V(2)(A) p.10
  - a. Changed language to read “the program will exempt one vehicle per licensed driver when that vehicle is used for employment, education and training, and/or transportation of family members”
8. Section V(3)(A) p.11
  - a. Changed language to “except the first \$1,000 plus 50%” and “and the first \$7,500 a year in tribal per capita payments”
9. Section IX p.21
  - a. Changed language to “the 2019 unemployment rate for Marin County is 2%” and “the 2019 Unemployment rate for Sonoma County is 2.4%”
10. Section X p.22-23 & 25
  - a. Changed language to “Parent(s)” and “parent(s) with a child under one year of age” and “TANF will exempt Parents in the following circumstances” (p.23) and “Parent(s) during the first year after giving birth to a child” (p.25)
11. Section XVII(9) p.31

- a. Changed language to “TANF will continue to provide cash assistance while an eligible Tribal TANF parent/needier caretaker is in an inpatient substance abuse treatment program for a maximum of 180 days”

- a. Added census income to excluded income
