**Position Purpose:** The Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria's Tribal TANF Program of Sonoma and Marin Counties serves Native American families that are in need with temporary cash assistance and supportive services. Under the direct supervision of the TANF Program Manager the Summer Youth Worker I provides direct services and activities, such as art, athletics, math, academic studies, to at-risk youth participants based on the mission and goals of the TANF Program and the Tribe's mission to help support all Native American families and youth.

### **Minimum Mandatory Qualifications**

#### Experience:

- Relevant experience working with youth and at-risk youth preferred.

#### Education:

- High School diploma or equivalent (GED).

#### License/Certification:

- Must possess a valid driver's license and be insurable under the Tribe's policy.

#### Preferred Qualifications:

- CPR and First Aid Certifications.

#### **Background and Pre-employment testing:**

Must successfully clear pre-employment testing, including, but not limited to a criminal background check, fingerprinting, TB test and drug and alcohol screening.

#### **FIGR CITIZENS AND INDIAN PREFERENCE WILL APPLY**

The Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria is a federally recognized Indian tribe, and, pursuant to its Indian Preference Statute, gives preference in hiring in the following order of priority: (1) Citizens of the Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria, (2) Native Americans who are members of or affiliated with a California Indian Tribe with ties to Marin and Sonoma Counties, (3) Native Americans who are members of or affiliated with any other California Indian Tribe, and (4) other Native Americans who are members of a Federally Recognized Indian Tribe.

Applicants asserting American Indian preference must submit verifying information, such as written confirmation of tribal membership, Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood, or other documentary evidence.
